## APPLICATION FOR FUNDING ITALIAN AT YOUR SCHOOL

In an effort to promote the study of the Italian language in U.S. schools, the government of Italy allocates funds each year to support the teaching of the Italian language in public and private schools. These funds are specifically earmarked for students from pre-school through 8th grades, and in some cases high school students. These funds are granted by the Italian Consulate of San Francisco to schools in their jurisdiction and are issued to the schools through The Italian Cultural Society, a nonprofit organization, which has been a community leader in California for over 27 years. Schools wishing to start, continue or expand an Italian Language Program are encouraged to apply for incentive funding to provide this valuable educational experience for their students.

New programs may be offered after school. However, highest funding priority will be given to schools that wish to include the study of the Italian language as part of their official school day. Grants amounts are calculated based on the school's cost for an hourly instructor's salary. The grant cannot be applied towards benefits, travel time, administrative time, etc. Textbooks and other learning materials can also be provided for use in school's Italian program.

All schools in the jurisdiction of the Italian Consulate of San Francisco (Hawaii, Idaho, Oregon, Utah, Alaska) interested in applying for grant funding for Italian studies are invited to complete and returning the enclosed application form to The Italian Cultural Society by April 16, 2010. All proposals will be reviewed and grants will be awarded based on the merits of the application and on availability of funds from the government of Italy.
