

**Advanced Italian 1:** Students learn to understand a wider range texts, and recognize idiomatic phrases and implied meaning. They will practice expressing ideas fluently and spontaneously without much obvious assistance. Can use language flexibly and effectively for social purposes and can produce clear, well-structured, cohesive sentences. They will learn to communicate about a large range of topics including art, politics, the world of work, and express ideas and opinions. They will use a broad variety of verbs tenses including the remote past, and begin to learn the subjunctive tense and its use. Italian is the classroom language. English is used only for clarification and grammar explanations.
