Advanced Italian 2: Students at this level are completing the course textbook and understand a wider range texts, they can recognize many idiomatic phrases and understand the implied meaning. Students at this level practice expressing ideas fluently and spontaneously without much assistance. They can use language flexibly and effectively for a variety of social purposes and can produce clear, well-structured, and cohesive sentences. They will learn to communicate about a large range of topics including art, politics, the world of work, and express ideas and opinions. They will use a broad variety of verbs tenses including the remote past, and begin to learn the subjunctive tense and its use. Italian is the primary classroom language. English may be used only for clarification and grammar explanations.
