Garibaldi-Meucci Museum, Staten Island



The **Garibaldi-Meucci Museum** is Located in Staten Island, New York. The museum was the home of the Italian American inventor, Antonio Meucci, from 1850 - 1889 and was a refuge for Giuseppe Garibaldi, the Italian "George Washington" and legendary hero for the Unification of Italy.

Garibaldi was forced to leave Italy and fled to the United States after the defeat of his Army in Rome but returned to Italy in 1854 and led his forces to victory which unified and established Italy as a nation and won him worldwide fame. By 1857, Antonio Meucci had developed a working model of the telephone in his home and obtained a patent for it years before Alexander Graham Bell but was unable to finance its development. Later, Bell obtained a patent and Meucci died before his legal claim as inventor of the telephone could be completed. After Meucci's death, the house was turned over to the Italian community. Today, the Meucci house is a National Landmark operated by the Sons of Italy Foundation as a Museum and Cultural Center with exhibits honoring Garibaldi and Meucci and offering a strong Italian cultural program.


